2019 AAI SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC.

The AAI Scholarship Fund, Inc. requests nominees for multiple scholarships covering aviation administration, flight, and maintenance.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- graduate of an Indiana high school,
- enrolled in the second year of a two-year aviation program or the third or fourth years of a four-year aviation program at an Indiana college or university,
- achieving average-or-better grades,
- actively participating in extracurricular activities or work experience, and
- have an unmet financial need (this may be certified by a faculty member).

Nominees may not be, nor be related to, a member of Aviation Indiana or anyone serving on the Board of AAI Scholarship Fund, Inc.

Each college or university is encouraged to provide at least **three nominees for each** of the aviation administration, flight, and maintenance disciplines. The nominations should include the attached scholarship application and a letter of recommendation from an appropriate faculty member.

Completed applications with their accompanying letters of recommendation should be received by **April 19, 2019**. The scholarship selection committee's decisions will be made at Aviation Indiana's July meeting, and the formal presentation of the scholarships will be made at Aviation Indiana's Annual Conference Awards Banquet on Wednesday, October 16, 2019, at the Blue Chip Casino/Hotel in Michigan City, Indiana.
